Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be:

- from Hale County, Alabama
- a previous staff member or camper at Sawyerville Summer Camp (preference will be given to those who have been both a staff member and a camper)
- accepted or enrolled in an institution of college rank or a technical school
- pursuing professional certification or degree
- able to show financial need

Application Process

Applications will open October 12, 2021, and close on February 28, 2022. Scholarship awards will be made in March 2022.

An application for a scholarship may be made every year a student is in college or technical school. Preference will be given to those people that have not received a scholarship two years in a row in an effort to make room for new scholarship recipients as much as we can.

To apply by mail, students should mail a completed application to 521 20th Street North, Birmingham, AL 35203. Applications must be postmarked by February 28, 2022.

A completed application includes:

- application form*
- recent transcript
- a brief description of your school and community accomplishments, your Sawyerville Summer Camp involvement, and what you hope to accomplish in the future by either attending college or a vocational program.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Granted funds are mailed directly to the registrar's office of the college or technical school of the recipient's choice.
