

CAMPERS

Campers are ages 6-13 and live in Hale County. Campers may attend only one session. Register all campers in your household for the same session. Check the session dates and list sessions in order of your preference.

Campers are grouped by rising grade level into Lower Camp (1st-3rd grade), Middler Camp (4th-6th grade), and Upper Camp (7th-8th grade).

LOCATION

Sawyerville Summer Camp takes place at Greensboro Elementary School. Hale County school buses will be available to take campers to and from camp.

Each day, campers will travel by school bus to Marion where they will swim at a pool under the supervision of certified lifeguards and several adults.

If your form is received by April 10th, you will receive a confirmation post card in the mail at the beginning of June. Bring this post card with you to registration the Saturday before your camper's session.

At registration, campers will receive a free backpack, water bottle, swim suit, and pool towel to use during the camp session. We will also have free books for all!
